
Our population is projected to reach 670,000 in 2050. What do you think?

# Rank the best ways to optimize the region's transportation system:

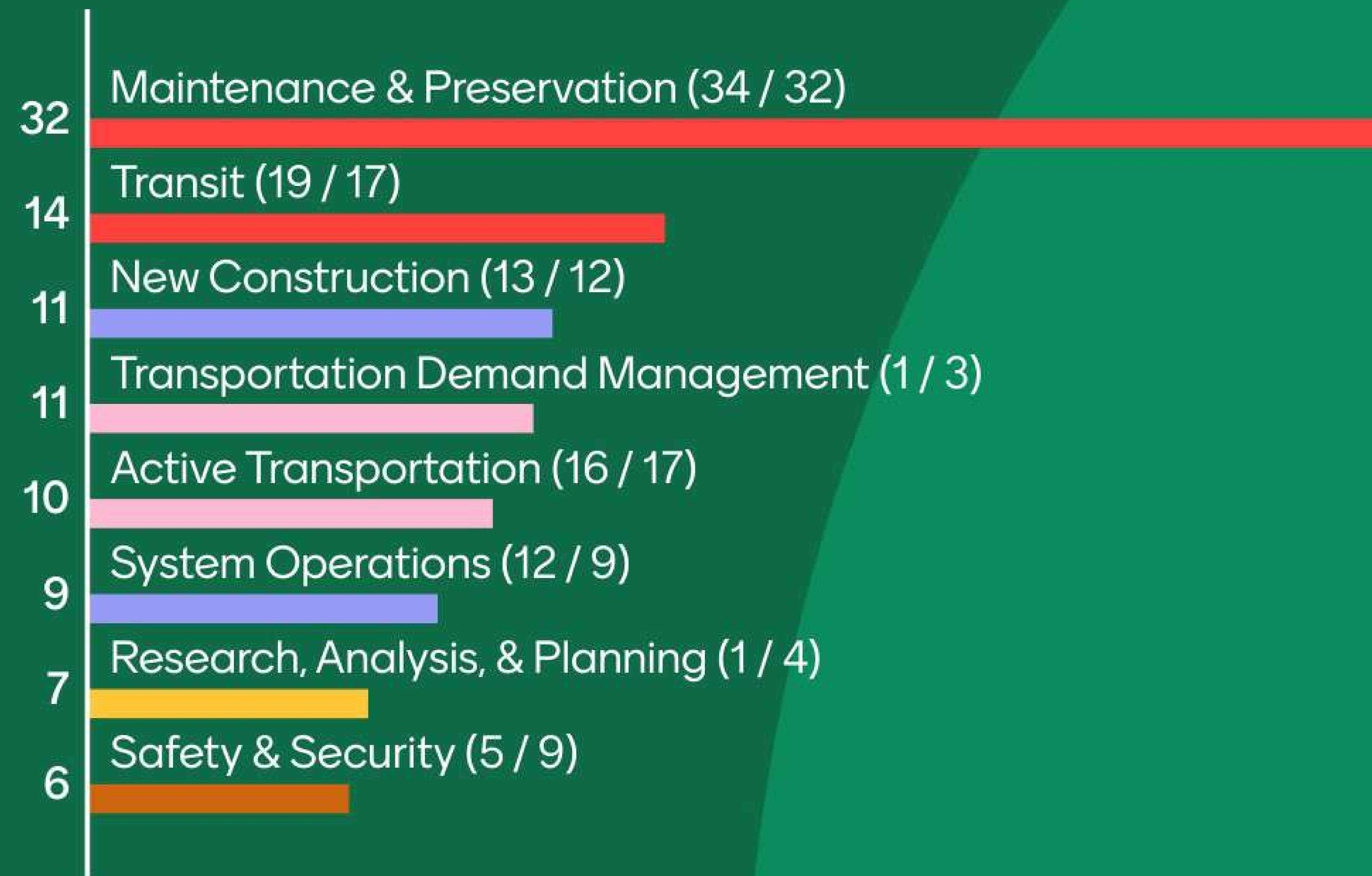




# What are the best options to explore to supplement declining Gas Tax revenue?
