








What is SRTC

- Metropolitan Planning Organization
 (MPO): an agency created by federal law
 to provide local elected officials input into
 the planning and implementation of
 federal transportation funds. 3C planning
 process.
- Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO): to facilitate the coordination and cooperation among state and local jurisdictions for transportation planning and comprehensive plans.




