



Blueprint of projects, programs, strategies for the regional transportation system. All modes.





What is SRTC

- **Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO):** an agency created by federal law to *provide local elected officials input into the planning and implementation of federal transportation funds.* 3C planning process.
- **Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO):** to facilitate the coordination and cooperation among state and local jurisdictions for transportation planning and comprehensive plans.



 - Bicycle – identifies existing and future bicycle facilities


Regional Bicycle Priority Network
